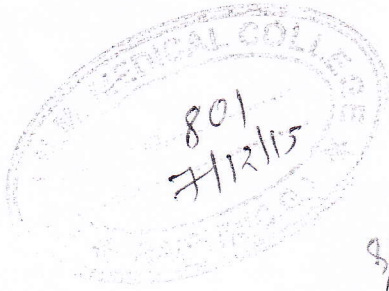

I am directed to refer to Medical Council of India letter No. MCI-37(1)(Recog/RI-18)(UG)/2013-Med./140486 dated 09.10.2015 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government to the recommendation of Medical Council of India for recognition of the MBBS degree awarded by the Ayush University of Health Sciences, Raipur for increased number of seats from 100 to 150 in respect of the students of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Medical College, Raipur.

2. The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
