It is 24 km from Raipur at Kumhari.



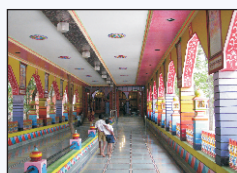
Nandanvan :

Raipur.



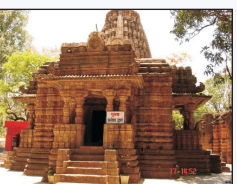
Champan
It is about 60 km from Raipur, is a birthplace of the **Saint Vallabhacharya**.



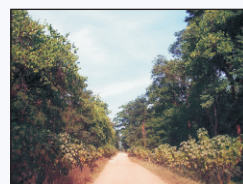
Ghatarani & Jatmai :
It is around 85 km from Raipur. Jatmai is 25 Kms from Ghatarani.



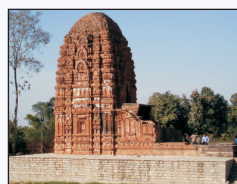
Rajim : Rajim is 45 km from Raipur. **Shri Rajiv Lochan Mandir**, dedicated to Lord Vishnu.



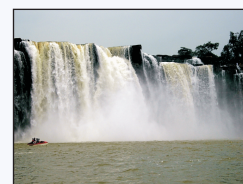
Bhoramdeo : It is known as 'Khajuraho of Chhattisgarh', situated 120 kilometres from Raipur.

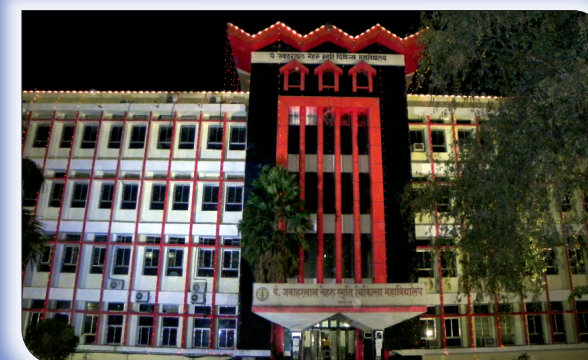
