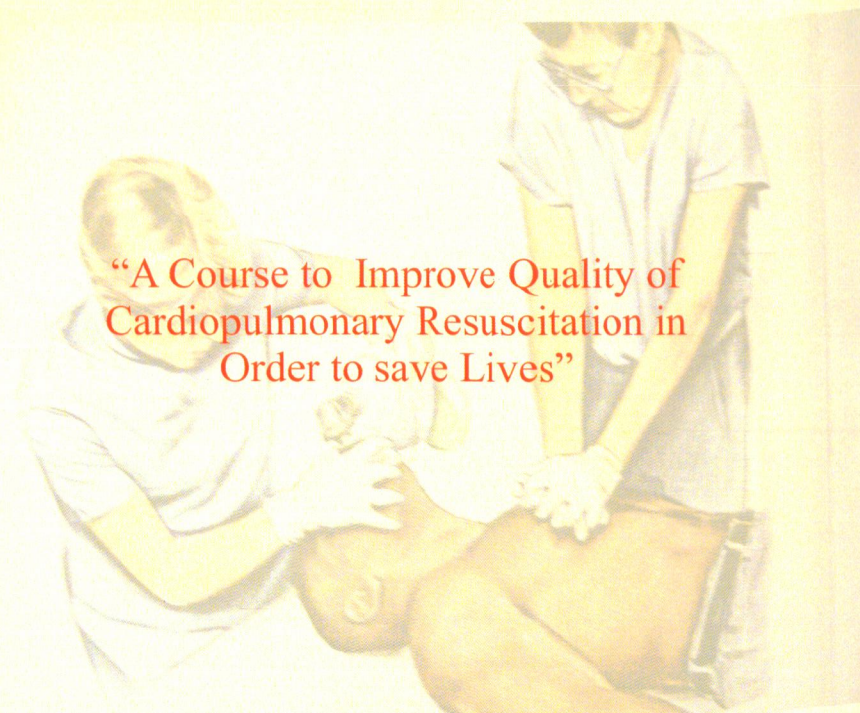

- * Recognize and initiate early management of peri-arrest conditions, such as tachyarrhythmias and bradyarrhythmias.
- * Proficient in providing quality chest compression, ventilation and integrated AED use, intubation, ECG interpretation, LMA insertion.
- * Manage cardiac arrest until return of spontaneous circulation, termination of resuscitation or transfer of care.
- * Manage respiratory arrest.
- * Identify and treat ischemic chest pain. (Acute coronary syndrome)
- * Recognize other life-threatening clinical situation, such as stroke, choking and provide effective initial care.

Basic Life Support (BLS)

The BLS Healthcare Provider Course teaches CPR skills for victims of all ages, including In-hospital and out-of-hospital

- Identifying cardiac arrest victim
- Ventilation with a barrier device, bag-mask device and oxygen
- Chest Compression
- Use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED)
- Relief of foreign-body airway obstruction (EBAO)

Eligibility Criteria for BLS

- Any medical graduate (MBBS, BAMS, MHMS, DAS, BPT & PMHM)
- Nursing & Paramedical staff with one year experience in reputed set up.
- People working in Police, Firebrigade, Airport, Swimming pools, Gyms.

Advance Cardiac life support (ACLS)

The ACLS provider course provides the knowledge and skills needed to evaluate and manage core ACLS case :

- Respiratory emergency
- Four types of cardiac arrest (simple VF/VT, complex VF/VT, PEA and asystole)
- Four types of prearrest emergencies (stable & unstable bradycardia & tachycardia, stroke and ACS)

Eligibility Criteria for ACLS

- Medical graduate (special category : BAMS, BHMS, BPT, PMHM can be considered on individual basis depending on their experience in clinical settings)
- BDS candidates are eligible depending on their experience
- Nursing candidates with minimum one year ICU experience
