Quality assurance (QA) and quality control (QC) are essential aspects of any laboratory testing process. Both ensure that the data generated by the laboratory are consistent from one day to the next and that the results from one laboratory can be compared with those generated by others. The key features of any laboratory QC system are that the system is documented, understood, stable, reliable and supports continuous quality improvement. The laboratory must be able to demonstrate that there is a 'system' in place and not just a series of uncoordinated activities. These activities must be subject to audit (external and internal) and review. Awareness regarding quality control amongst the healthcare professionals and associates will not only help in better diagnostic and management of disease but also reduce the costs and sufferings caused by inappropriate diagnosis and repeat testings.

Taking into consideration the prevalence of various hematological disorders in population of Chhattisgarh, it is necessary that the clinicians be updated and enlightened with the recent updates and novel technologies associated in diagnosis and treatment of these disorders. Also how can we prevent the occurrence of these disorders needs to be explored and conveyed from time to time at the grassroots levels of service providers which essentially includes the clinicians and subject experts.
