JDA hails Ministry's directive to NMC on fixing duty hours for resident docs

RAIPUR, July 5

THE Junior Doctors' Association (JDA) at Pt Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Medical College (Pt. JNMCC) in Raipur has welcomed the latest move by the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, which has writ-

ten to the National Medical Commission (NMC) seeking urgent implementation of fixed duty hour standards for resident doctors across India. The association termed the directive as "long overdue" and reiterated its earlier demands for uniform application of duty norms to preserve the well-being and digni-

ty of junior doctors.

JDA Raipur stated that excessive, erratic duty hours not only induce mental and physical exhaustion among medical residents but also impact their ability to deliver quality patient care.

The association has been consistently advocating for reforms through formal memorandums, referencing national precedents and medical ethics.

The issue of prolonged shifts has been flagged repeatedly - from the Supreme Court's 1987 order capping work at 48 hours per week, to the MoHFW's 1992 guideline mandating 12-hour daily duty with weekly rest, and the PGMER 2023 recommendations labelling 36-hour continuous shifts as "inhumane".

Calling it a critical moment, JDA Raipur urged the authorities to ensure effective and uniform enforcement of duty hour reforms across all medical institutions.

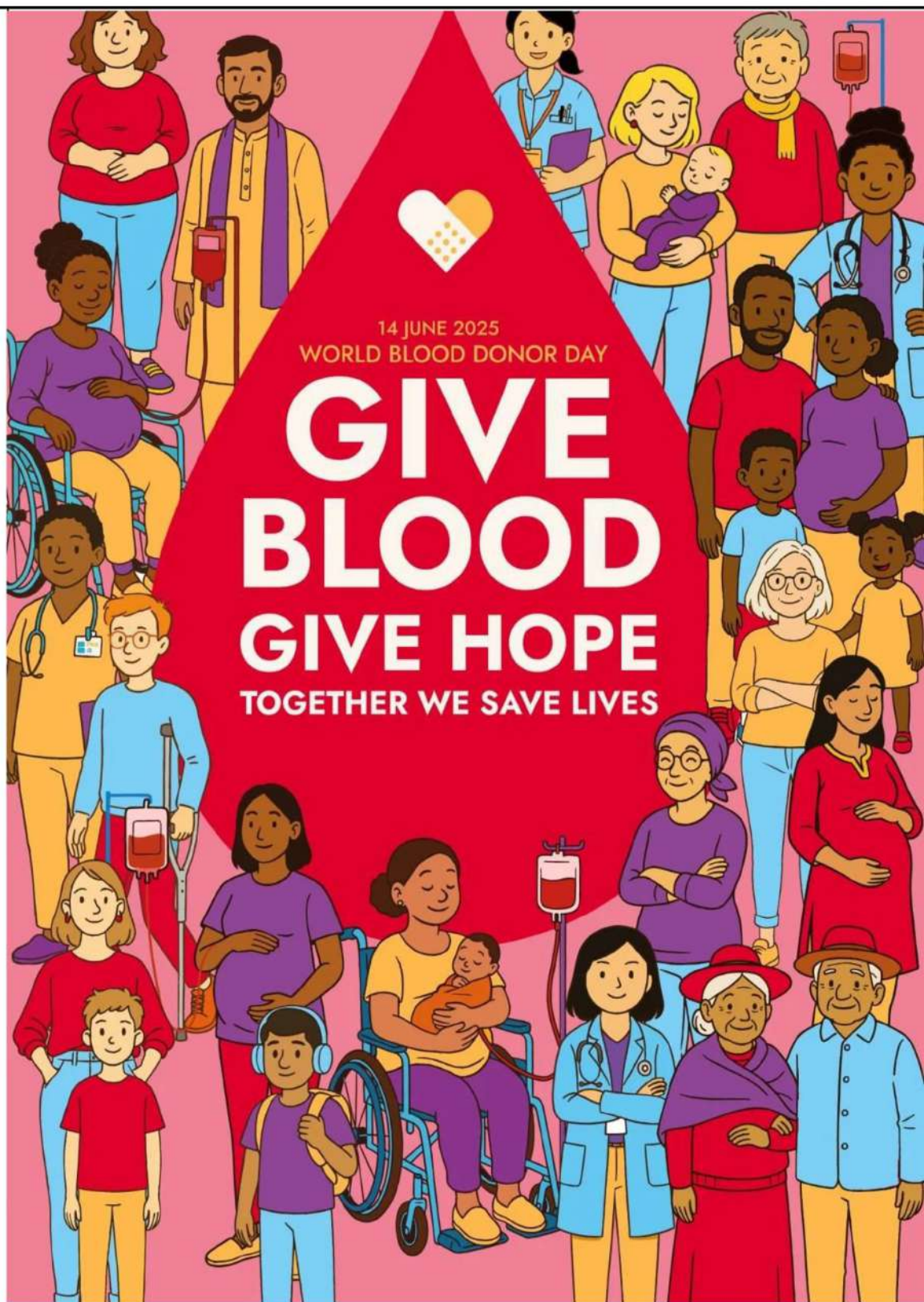



JDA, medical leaders demand reforms in CG health sector after bond relief

RAIPUR, July 25

A JOINT delegation of Junior Doctors Association (JDA), Chhattisgarh Indian Doctors Association (CIDA), Indian Medical Association (IMA) and CGDF met Health Minister Shyam Bihari Jaiswal in Raipur, expressing gratitude for the government's landmark decision to reduce the MBBS bond service tenure from two years to one year.

Led by JDA President Dr Resham Singh and Secretary Dr Amit Banjara, and accompanied by BJP leader and Medical Cell Convenor Vimal Chopra, the delegation presented a detailed memorandum of systemic demands. Foremost among them was the synchronisation of bond amounts and durations for both MBBS and PG medical students. They also sought a transparent, time-bound, and simplified deployment system for post-PG bond service.

The delegation pressed for reforms in Ayushman Bharat payment disbursals,

calling for timely and transparent compensation. CIDA representatives urged correction of pay anomalies, immediate implementation of Non-Practicing Allowance (NPA), and faster recruitment into the state's regular medical service to meet staff shortages. On the infrastructure front, concerns were raised about the lack of hostel accommodation at Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru Memorial Medical College (PtJNMMC), Raipur. In response, the Health Minister instructed the department to prepare a roadmap for an eight-storey hostel facility, replacing the earlier two-storey proposal.

Minister Jaiswal assured the delegation that every issue raised would be examined with priority. "You are the backbone of our future health system. I will ensure restrictive regulations like bond guarantees are reviewed for fairness and feasibility," he said. The delegation expressed confidence that these steps would enhance healthcare delivery and raise the morale of young doctors across State.
